
The Logo on this page is something we have made. You might like to dream up a new name and try your hand at a logo.

- * Some hard questions and easy ones. Just to help you understand the story. You will find the answers in the story so you can go looking.




- * Things to do. Things to make.

Let the children come

Instructions to make up your mini book. You might need to ask an adult to help you.

- 1. Cut along the two thin black lines at each end of your page.
- 2. Fold the two short sides together. Press firmly on the fold.
- 3. Fold again so that you have now folded in quarters.
- 4. Fold the whole thing in half to make the page size. Press all folds firmly.
- 5. Cut through on the black line for the length of one page only.
- 6. Unfold completely.
- 7. Now fold your paper lengthways.
- 8. Take hold of each end and press towards the middle. Your cut sections pop out and your two end piece meet in the middle
- 9. Hey presto. You have your minibook.


